VISIT DETAILS

The primary purpose of our visit is to stimulate the pupils interest in the marvels of nature and make them aware of how important it is to conserve the

A wide range of subjects are covered within the National Curriculum including life processes, living things, adaptation, flight, camouflage, population dynamics, natural history, predator-prey relationships, food chains, habitat destruction and pollution.

Birdman is also happy to cover any other specific subjects upon request.



AGE GROUPS AND SUITABILITY

Anyone of any age will enjoy watching the birds fly. However, most of our visits range from 4yrs old and work up from there.

The presentation will be in a language aimed specifically at your pupils age group whether they are nursery children or university students.

Analogies relating to their everyday life and experiences are used to ensure they understand the information they receive.

Should you have a wide range of children we are happy to do more than one presentation according to age. After seeing each bird fly, the pupils are encouraged to ask questions. These will be repeated before answering them sensitively, with new words to the pupils, explained in plain English in relation to their level of understanding.

WHERE WHAT AND WHEN?



The presentation will be held inside your assembly/sports hall thus enabling it to be completely non-weather dependent. The pupils and birds, also concentrate better in a controlled environment. The birds are trained to fly inside and the the Bald Eagle, with a 2 metre wingspan, flying over the heads of the teachers and pupils, has a profound effect.

Birdman visits all year round and travels all over the UK. He has no set radius. So please enquire!

DOES THE SCHOOL PAY?

Technically, no! The usual package chosen by schools is when we visit **free of charge**. All that is asked is that prior to our visit, a letter is sent home to parents informing them of our upcoming visit and offering their child the chance to have their photo taken holding a Bird of Prey on their gloved hand for £5! This offers the children an amazing handling opportunity whilst also creating a unique souvenir as they will later receive a 5" x 7" mounted photograph. However if the school prefers not to take the photograph option a fee is payable.
